

DBNSW Online Registration Information

Returning Paddlers

If you are a returning paddler, you should now have received email from DBNSW to renew your membership online. This membership renewal system will greatly assist and simplify things for your club administrator and committee.

Once you log in with your username and password:

1. log on to www.dbnsw.org.au
2. Click on DragonBoat Matters >
3. New/Renewing membership >
4. **Renewing** Member
5. Enter username and password >
6. **Click on the “Registration Renewal” area in the left hand navigation bar**
7. Read and accept the 3 declarations (check the tick box under each declaration)
8. Update any details we may have gotten wrong or that have changed for you (address, phone, email, etc). Double check the male/female button has been ticked correctly (it seems to be defaulting to female if left un-ticked ...sorry guys?!).
9. Note: Play by the rules = 1/1/2010 is a default date – no need to change
10. Can you swim 50m – Y/N (please make sure you answer this question honestly as it is important for insurance purposes)
11. Keep scrolling down and answering any questions applicable to you
12. At this time you can also update your username and password to something easier for you to remember (eg PJeffery / your own password)
13. Once you are finished you will receive 2 confirmation emails/receipts
